Camp Winnebago is a non profit organization dedicated to serving the recreational needs of adults and children with developmental disabilities.

Counselors, Cabin Leaders, & Program Leaders:

Counselors – Duties include the direct personal care and welfare of all assigned campers and participate in all activities with assigned campers.

Cabin Leaders – Plan and organize activities and all aspects of camper care in your assigned cabin. Assist with motivating counselors.

Nature Leader – Plan and lead a variety of outdoor nature activities for campers. Maintain nature equipment. Assist counselors and cabin leaders as needed.

Sports & Games Leader - Plan and lead activities to give campers exercise. Maintain sports equipment. Assist counselors and cabin leaders as needed.

Aquatics Leader - Must have American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification. Instruct campers in pool activities and responsible for safety of all water activities. Assist counselors and cabin leaders as needed.

Music & Drama Leader - Plan and carry out musical activities that stimulate campers. Plan and lead songs at meals and other times. Assist counselors and cabin leaders as needed.

Arts & Crafts Leader – Plan and implement arts and crafts projects to give campers a sense of accomplishment and creativity. Assist counselors and cabin leaders as needed.

TMA's – Under the supervision of the Registered Nurse, provide medication to campers throughout the week. Assist the nurse with other day/evening duties.

Registered Nurse – In charge of all camper medications, care of campers and staff, and the supervision of TMA's.

Assistant Maintenance – Under the supervision of Head Maintenance must be able to run chain saw, run general machinery, do general building repairs, and lawn care.

Housekeeping – Must be able to handle large quantities of laundry which includes laundry pickup & delivery to cabins, general housekeeping in all buildings.

Assistant Program Director – Assist the program director in daily activities.

All positions include weekly salaries, room and board, meals, laundry facilities, 1 week of professional inservice and training, and off duty recreational opportunities. Must live at camp Monday – Friday. Job start date is June 6, 2011. Job end date is August 12, 2010. Must work 1 Sunday (July 17) for youth week.
